1. ROLL CALL

2. SUPERVISOR UPDATE

Supervisor Kennedy said that in the past three months he has been attending meetings and been part of a couple subcommittees; Public Works and Government Ops/Insurance. He said he expects to be appointed to one different committee in 2023. He announced that the proposed county budget is on their website, and it is worth noting that all counties are being made aware of the increased need for mental health services with clarification on amounts coming in the next year. He added that additional funds will be coming to us because of the pandemic and from the opioid settlements. He said that the County will be holding their annual organizational meeting January 5th. He said that no DMV services are being offered at this time in Geneva and not for the foreseeable future. He said that he is hoping by the second quarter of next year for possible opportunities. He reported that the Ontario County Humane Society received 87 complaints for pets with 36% of the complaints coming from people in Geneva. He noted that 26 animals were admitted during November leaving them with a total of 74 animals. He said that the Office for the Aging has a gift giving tree in the lobby of their Canandaigua Office. Residents can call to have arrangements made to have a gift identified from the tree. He reported the Electronic/Hazardous Waste Collection on October 22nd was a success with 47 residents participating.

Supervisor Kennedy said there will be a public hearing held December 8th including local law #7 increasing supervisor's salaries. He noted that there have been three residents who have made comments about the landfill. He said that anyone interested in speaking can call their respective supervisor. Lastly, he reported he will be participating in a full comprehensive Board of Supervisors orientation on December 28th.

3. AMENDMENT TO THE AGENDA

Clr. Camera asked to make an amendment to the agenda to remove item XII B under new business to allow him time to review the material again.

4. DRI UPDATE

Thank you, Mayor and City Councilors and good evening. On behalf of the DPW, Barton & Loguidice (B&L) and Nardoizzi Construction, we want to please thank all residents, business owners and visitors for their continued patience.

WORK COMPLETED TO DATE:

As of the last Progress Meeting / Site Walk Through held Friday November 4, 2022, the contractor has used 100% of the contract time and has completed 88% of the proposed work. The current **draft** Pay Estimate # 14, dated November 23, 2022 shows completed work to date was \$8.8 M out of \$10.2 M. The contract substantial completion date was at end of October 2022. The contractor has submitted requests for substantial completion acceptance, pay quantity discrepancy review and contract extensions of time which are all being investigated.

UPCOMING WORK SCHEDULED:

Contract 1, "5&20 Corridor" continues to be in Phase 1C. Work is not yet completed on all underground electrical work, traffic signal upgrades, landscaping, and permanent signage. Work Zone Traffic Control will continue until all proposed traffic signal work can be properly installed.

Contract 2, "Street Scape and 5 Points" continues to be in Phase 2C. Work is not yet completed on all underground electrical work, traffic signal upgrades, and landscaping.

CONCERNS:

BUZZUTO – Rain Collection Structure is not completed,

ELECTRICAL – Subcontractor traffic signal material and equipment delays continue

BUDGET - Anticipate that all final completed contractor work to come in right at or just under the original base bid of \$10.2M to approximately \$9.8.

5. FOUNDRY UPDATE

Remedial Design

- NYSDEC's engineering contractor continued remedial design activities for remaining properties located south of Lewis Street on Genesee, Geneva, and Tillman streets. Designs were completed for 10 properties in this area east of Geneva Street and north of Tillman. Structural inspections were completed at two properties on Geneva and Tillman streets. Remediation of all properties south of Lewis Street is expected to be performed in 2023.
- Remedial designs were completed for 60 Middle Street, which has been used as a project staging area. Trailers, materials, and equipment are being removed from the parcel, and remedial excavation is anticipated to be conducted in January 2023.
- A community update factsheet will be prepared and sent to property owners and other community stakeholders in early 2023.

Remedial Construction

- Excavation was completed at Genesee Park, including around the large oak tree and three other trees that were protected in place. Some of the replacement trees are anticipated to be planted this month. The city completed installation of new electrical service throughout the park, supported by the project contractor. The central sidewalk will be installed by the project mason in the spring of 2023, along with the new concrete features being installed by the city. Additional replacement trees and plantings will also be planted in the spring of 2023. In consultation with the City, the park will be closed for the winter.
- Excavation and restoration activities were substantially completed on the north and east sides of St. Peter's Church along Lewis and Geneva streets.
- Replacement trees are being installed at properties both east and west of Exchange Street. Additional replacement plants and trees will be installed in spring 2023.

The project contractor will continue performing some restoration and demobilization work in December, but no new excavation will be performed until January. Therefore, NYSDEC anticipates the next project update will be provided prior to the February 2023 monthly council meeting.

Clr. Gaglianese asked about the additional funding request for the Genesee Park, and how much has been spent at this point. City Manager Hendrix and Comptroller Newcomb said they would get those numbers to council.

Clr. Salamendra said that any neighbors of Genesee Park, or people with an opinion about the statue, can reach out to her.

6. PRESENTATION – JOULE ASSETS

Jessica Stromback, Hannah Karp, and Shannon Bellamy of Joule Assets said that they were here tonight to talk about the Community Choice Aggregate Program (CCA). Ms. Stromback said that they are getting ready to renew the Town of Geneva's contract as they have had two successful contracts already. She said that this is the exploratory and public education phase. She said their job is to bring stability and transparency to the electricity market. She noted that electricity costs are going up and it is harder for residents to manage their budget. She said that in this past year, the participating residents have saved over \$11 million on their electricity bills, and while they can't guarantee that there will always be savings, this program brings stability. She said that this is a chance for us to negotiate a better price. She said that the outreach and education phase will include information on the city website and is a 60-day process. She said that they send out a request for proposals so the city can see the prices and availability of renewables. Once approved, the city signs the contract, and we are on our way. The city can choose to set the rate for 18-24 months or a smaller timeframe like 4 months. She said we would have group purchasing power, and it would be an opt-out program.

Hannah Karp said that residents can join or leave at any time without a penalty because we are doing this as a group. She said that in the notification period, everyone will receive a letter telling them how to opt out. She said they can call the helpline, visit the website, or return a card in the prepaid envelope. She said they can also opt back in later. She said that it may take one or two billing cycles for residents to see the difference. When asked if there was a financial benefit to the city, Shannon Bellamy said that the Town of Geneva received a benefit as a result of them signing up for solar power because Joule was offering money back as an incentive, but that is no longer an option. When asked if any residents would not be eligible, she said that residents who receive support from the HEAP program or anyone who has already made their own choice.

Ms. Karp said that there are many different avenues for putting the information out to residents, and they will be hosting public information sessions with Joule paying for all of the advertisements. Ms. Bellamy said that Joule sends out all of the information, but it is tailored to the city's needs.

8. PUBLIC COMMENT

Jessica Farrell presented council with a handout showing information from the report on GPD staffing levels. She said my comments tonight are in reference to the study of the GPD staffing levels. This report has a lot of important information, and I'm grateful to have it as a resource. It answers some questions, and it also raises questions. Per the City Manager's request at your last meeting, I am sending my questions to Erica Collins, but I would also like to publicly raise certain concerns and encourage you to look into them as well. First is the fact that the report does not study or analyze how many sergeants we should have at all, even though it is clear that the number of sergeants impacts the report's recommendations for how many uniformed officers the department should have. For example, it states on page 11 that the report's conclusion of a need for more uniformed officers "may be *somewhat* diminished by the sergeants' positions." This is saying that, were the study to examine the number of sergeants, it might draw different conclusions about the number of uniformed officers needed. But it didn't analyze sergeants, so it can't rule that out. So, to reiterate: the report makes it clear that the number of sergeants impacts the number of uniformed officers needed, but since this report starts its analysis from a presumption of how many sergeants the GPD has without analyzing and explaining that number, the report's conclusions about how many uniformed officers are needed are based on an incomplete picture and cannot be relied upon without further information. But, even if we were to put aside that gap in the foundation of this study—which, I would argue you can't do, but I will do it anyway—I'd also like to speak about the calculations that the report makes. And I apologize, this gets into specific calculations and so I've provided you with a handout of the specific charts that I'm referencing. On page 9 of the report, there is a calculation made of the minimum number of "posts" or officer assignments needed to cover the expected workload of each shift based on the average calculated call volume. That number is then "adjusted" (or, in other words, rounded—up or down) so that, in the last column, it is a whole number. These adjusted numbers—not the actual numbers produced by the calculations—are then used on page 11 to determine the total number of officers who should be hired. Given that high school math teaches us that you should not round until the end of your calculations otherwise you are being inaccurate, we need to ask ourselves why the study used the adjusted numbers on page 11 instead of the exact numbers. The report doesn't explain, so I've tried to think about if it was necessary to use the adjusted numbers, and I've come to the conclusion that it wasn't—but I'm just a layperson here, so it's worth asking the professionals. I don't have time to explain all the reasons I think it is not only ok but better to use the actual numbers instead of the adjusted numbers, so I'll follow up with an email about that, but for now I'll just say: There is not a one-to-one correlation between officers hired and posts to fill because the number of posts that must be filled is based on the availability factor of 1.78—that reflects how to take into consideration vacation days and sick days and all of those other factors that could make an officer unable to work a given shift—and since that factor is 1.78, the number of police officers in the chart on page 11 also needs to be adjusted/rounded in the final column in order to give a concrete number of people to hire

(you can't hire half an officer). So, since you have to round on page 11 anyway, using the exact numbers from page 9 instead of the adjusted numbers is better so you are not rounding twice. Anyway, like I said, I'd be happy to explain further why I believe the exact not adjusted numbers can be used in the calculation on page 11, but in the interest of time, I'd like to just show you what happens if we do use those actual numbers. That is the bottom chart on your paper. As you can see, it changes the numbers significantly when compared to the report. In the report's chart on page 11, when the numbers are adjusted, they are all rounded up (none of them are rounded down, even on the afternoon shift when technically the need is for 7.12 officers, that becomes 8 officers). If we follow that pattern and round all of the numbers in my chart up, as I did for you, you'll see that this calculation using the actual not rounded need for posts, says that the number of officers needed is 19, not 20 like the report says. I also think we could also make a case for rounding both up and down here in this chart, as they did in the chart on page 9—so there is precedent within this report for rounding down—because, as the report states, uniformed officers are also supported by sergeants, lieutenants, and even the chief if there are patrol needs that exceed the number of officers on a shift. If you were to round down here, the morning shift's real need of 5.2 officers would be rounded down to 5, with the knowledge that some other employees might help out on particularly busy shifts. And then the actual number of uniformed officers the department needs would be 18. Again, I'm sorry to be so number focused, but I wanted to show you how even something as small as rounding the number of posts required for a given shift can really skew the number of recommended hires by up to 2 officers. The city should investigate how these calculations were made and not take them at face value.

Penny Hankins said that she was following up on public comment that she gave in May of 2021 during Mental Health Awareness month, saying that per the administrative study of the Geneva Police Department, it seems we need to replace a few police officers with mental health workers to handle the flow of mental health calls and overdoses. She said that according to this study, the Geneva Police Department is seeing that calls of this nature are increasing. She said we need a mental health crisis team like the one Rochester has called Person in Crisis (PIC) that steps in when police officers might inadvertently escalate a mental health or substance abuse situation. She said we need this in Geneva as you can be the nicest police officer with the best communication skills, but it is what that uniform represents to that individual that can really set them off. She asked council to please consider her request.

Amaris Elliott-Engel said that she is a local attorney and member of the former Police Review Board, and she is here to comment on the staffing analysis done by the Division of Criminal Justice Services. She said her main question in evaluating the level of staffing is why professional staff are not being incorporated such as mental health professionals to deal with the mental health and substance abuse situations. She said it is not fair to police officers because of the staffing shortages. She noted that the Police Budget Advisory Board explored having mental health staff added to the police department.

Scott Bowes said that he recently ran for sixth ward councilor. He thanked all who supported him and agreed with what he stood for in his campaign, and he congratulated Clr. Brimm on his win. He said that he feels the Geneva Police Department has an excessive number of calls for property checks noting that this is a common problem across the United States. He said that the Camillus Police Department has a place on their website where residents can fill out a form when they are going away. He said with the high number of calls along with repeat calls, he wondered if the city could implement a small fine for officers being taken away from other, more important calls. He questioned if there were Genevans who feel the Geneva Police Department is their own personal security force. He said he also met with a sixth ward senior who told him the extended curbs in downtown are a hazard, and he suggested painting them bright colors to help drivers see them.

9. CITY MANAGER REPORT

City Manager Hendrix said that with regard with the Marsh Creek Pump Station, the project is moving forward. We hit a new level of completion today as connection between the new and old cells have been reached. The project is moving right along schedule.

We are moving forward with our Water Infrastructure Improvement and Intermunicipal (WIIA) Grant Program and awaiting additional information from NYS regarding program requirements as we move forward towards additional engineering programs.

The LDC met today and discussed the Revolving Loan Fund and their relationship with this group. They voted to reappoint Jim King, Jim Vedora, and Greg Woodworth for two-year terms each. They also appointed Jeffrey Kowalski and Joshua Burden.

The LDC and IDA are reviewing a proposal from the BID regarding Beautification. LDC voted to fund up to 50% of the proposal which will assist with funding additional seasonal staff, plant signage, volunteer recognition items, tools and more for the BID. The total staffing for the BID will be 2 FTE full time and 4 seasonal funded by the city and 2 seasonal from LDC and/or other partners for a total of 6 FTEs for next season. The IDA will be reviewing this proposal on Friday.

The Director of Planning and Economic Development search has been paused at this time.

We received notification that we will receive \$180,000 for the Microenterprise Assistance Program.

Ice Rink undergoing repairs this week and we believe operations will continue to be up all weekend. Thank you for your patience.

Thank you to City Staff team for the behind the scenes work to bring together the Mayors Tree Lighting.

10. RESOLUTION SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING IN CONNECTION WITH AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF EMPIRE STATE DEVELOPMENT FOR ROUND 7 OF THE RESTORE NY COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE FUNDING

City Manager Hendrix presented the following resolution:

WHEREAS, economic development, the creation of economic opportunity and housing are key priorities of the City of Geneva and the Geneva City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the citizens of Geneva to enhance housing, business and economic opportunity; and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2022 the City Manager was authorized to submit the intention to apply for the 2022 Empire State Development Restore NY Round 7 funding in anticipation of supporting the project on 88 Middle Street; and

WHEREAS, the funding agency requires a Public Hearing be held to collect citizen feedback on the community and needs of the City of Geneva and the proposed project prior to submission of said application;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a public hearing be held on January 4, 2023 at 7pm pursuant to New York State Open Meetings Law and the requirements concerning the proposed application for Round 7 of the NYSED Restore New York Communities Initiative.

City Manager Hendrix reminded everyone that this is for the Pretzel Logic project to move to 88 Middle Street, and this is just approving a public hearing for next month.

11. RESOLUTION EXTENDING CITY MANAGER'S TIME TO ESTABLISH RESIDENCE

City Manager Hendrix presented the following resolution:

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2022, the Geneva City Council appointed Amie Hendrix to serve as Geneva City manager by resolution 23-2022, and

WHEREAS, an Employment Agreement was thereafter executed formalizing Amie Hendrix's appointment as Geneva City Manager effective June 21, 2022, and

WHEREAS, subdivision A of Section 8 of the Employment Agreement required Amie Hendrix to establish residence within the corporate boundaries of the City within 6 months of the effective date of her employment, and

WHEREAS, Amie Hendrix has requested that the provisions of subdivision A of Section 8 of her Employment Agreement with the City requiring her to establish residence within the corporate boundaries of the City within 6 months of June 21, 2022 be extended.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that provisions of subdivision A of Section 8 of the Employment Agreement of City Manager between Amie Hendrix and the City of Geneva requiring her to establish residence within the corporate boundaries of the City within six months of June 21, 2022 be extended to allow her until March 31, 2023 to establish said residence.

12. RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PERMISSION TO ENTER UPON CITY PROPERTY FOR CLEARING, REMOVING TREES, BRUSH AND LIKE ACTIVITIES ON THE GREENWAY TRAIL

City Manager Hendrix presented the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town and the City of Geneva and Blueprint Geneva, Inc., have proposed a project for a Greenway Trail on City property known as the former Lehigh Valley Railroad right of way, tax map numbers 91.17-1-58, 90.20-3-30, and 90.20-1-45; and

WHEREAS, Blueprint Geneva, Inc, has asked that the City grant it and “the Friends of the Greenway” a volunteer group, access to the property for the purpose of clearing, removing trees, brush, and like activities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Geneva City Council, hereby and in due form, does grant Blueprint Geneva, Inc. and “the Friends of the Greenway”, permission to enter upon property owned by the City, tax map numbers 91.17-1-58, 90.20-3-30, and 90.20-1-45, said access to be used exclusively for activities related to the proposed Greenway Trail project, and it is further,

RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to execute the attached agreement, granting Blueprint Geneva, Inc. and “the Friends of the Greenway”, permission to enter upon property owned by the City, tax map numbers 91.17-1-58, 90.20-3-30, and 90.20-1-45, said access to be used exclusively for activities related to the proposed Greenway Trail project.

City Manager Hendrix told everyone that the Town and City of Geneva along with Blueprint Geneva have proposed a project for the greenway trail that is on city property. This is just granting permission to enter city property in coordination with the city, and there is no financial cost to the city outside of staff resources. Clr. Salamendra thanked the volunteers.

13. FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 335 ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" OF THE GENEVA MUNICIPAL CODE

City Manager Hendrix presented the following ordinance for first reading:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Geneva, New York that Chapter 335, entitled "Vehicles & Traffic" of the City of Geneva Municipal Code be amended:

WHEREAS, the City Code section 335-16 subdivision C, currently states as follows: No vehicles shall be parked on any other street in the City of Geneva between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. except during the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, October and November.", and

WHEREAS, the City Director of Public Works recommends the City Council adopt winter parking regulations.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDAINED, as follows

Section 335-16 subdivision C of the Geneva City Code, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

No vehicles shall be parked on any other street in the City of Geneva between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. and during a Weather Event except during the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, October and November.",

335-16 C. "Weather Event Regulations"

For purposes of this article, a Weather Event shall be defined a period of snow, sleet, freezing rain, ice, and any other weather event which results or reasonably can be expected to result in accumulation upon a street or highway of snow or ice. A Weather Event shall continue until such time as the City streets are fully cleared.

(1) Official notification of a Weather Event will be posted on the city website www.cityofgenevany.com and through alternative notification and social media systems.

(2) Parking prohibited during Weather Events.

It shall be unlawful and a violation of this article for any person to park or leave standing any vehicle on any of the public streets or state highways maintained by the City of Geneva within the confines of city limits during a Weather Event while the Department of Public Works plows, salts or engages in other activities to clear City streets and highways.

(3) Any vehicle found parked or standing on or upon a public street or state highway maintained by the City of Geneva within the confines of city limits during a Weather Event, shall be removed at the owner's expense, without any prior notice, and in accordance with the city's Ordinance governing the removal and impounding of vehicles, and all applicable rules and regulations governing removal and impounding of vehicles.

- (4) No Official Notification required if state of emergency declared.

In the event the State of New York declares a state of emergency due to serious snow, ice or similar events which is communicated to the public through the news media, the notice requirements of this Article shall not apply, and any vehicle found parked or standing on or upon a public street or state highway maintained by the City of Geneva within the confines of city limits shall be removed at the owner's expense, without any prior notice, and in accordance with the city's Ordinance governing the removal and impounding of vehicles, and all applicable rules and regulations governing removal and impounding of vehicles.

- (5) Enforcement.

In addition to enforcement provisions set forth above, the provisions of this Article pertaining to Weather Events shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions of this Code, including but not limited to Section 335.27 and Article VII of this Chapter. In the event the City is obligated to institute or defend a civil complaint arising out of enforcement, all attorneys' fees, disbursements and costs incurred by City of Geneva with respect to instituting or defending such action shall be the responsibility of the violator.

City Manager Hendrix told everyone that we have been following a pilot program since 2018, and this ordinance just makes it official. She noted that with this being the first reading there will be some potential modifications before the next reading, and one change is code section 335.27(c) that reads that we cannot charge more than \$90 to tow a vehicle, but the actual cost is much more. She recommends an additional ordinance change to change the wording to "the cost of towing" rather than putting in a dollar amount. She also said that this makes no change to the pilot.

14. RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY COMPTROLLER TO COLLECT TAX LIENS

City Comptroller Newcomb presented the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the City Comptroller has annually provided a list of properties in which there are certain accounts for housing inspections, grass cutting, rubbish removal and water charges, and in accordance with the City Charter must direct that a lien be placed upon these properties in order to allow the City to collect these bills in the same manner as taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Geneva, New York, that a lien be placed against the properties listed herein in the amount set forth and the City Comptroller levy, enforce and collect these liens in the same manner, at the same time and with the penalties as City taxes.

15. RESOLUTION AMENDING BYLAWS OF THE POLICE BUDGET ADVISORY BOARD AND REINSTATING JAMES MCCORKLE AND ROBERT MACLEAN

Mayor Valentino presented the following resolution:

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2020, the Geneva City Council created the Police Budget Advisory Board and, on October 7, 2020, adopted ByLaws for the Board which authorized five positions to serve for two years, and

WHEREAS, the Geneva City Council appointed James McCorkle and Robert Maclean to serve on the Police Budget Advisory Board for terms expiring on December 31, 2022, and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2022, the Geneva City Council removed James McCorkle and Robert Maclean from the Police Budget Advisory Board after statements McCorkle and Maclean made in their personal capacities concerning the police department and their political views.

WHEREAS, James McCorkle and Robert Maclean allege their removal from the Police Budget Advisory Board violated their rights to Free Speech and Due Process under the United States and New York State Constitutions, and

WHEREAS, A proposed Settlement Agreement to be entered into by James McCorkle and Robert Maclean and the City and the City Council has been presented to the City Council for its consideration, and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has recommended that James McCorkle and Robert Maclean be reinstated to the Police Budget Advisory Board.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the ByLaws of the City of Geneva Police Budget Advisory Board are hereby amended to temporarily expand the number of positions on the Board to seven by creating two temporary positions, and it is further

RESOLVED, that James McCorkle and Robert Maclean be reinstated to the Police Budget Advisory Board for a term commencing with the date this resolution is passed and ending on December 31, 2023, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the number of positions on the Police Budget Advisory Board shall revert to five upon James McCorkle and Robert Maclean completing the term of their reinstatement, and it further

RESOLVED, that the reinstatements of James McCorkle and Robert Maclean shall take effect upon the execution of a Settlement Agreement by James McCorkle and Robert Maclean, releasing, remising, and

forever discharging the City and members of the City Council from all claims arising out of their June 1, 2022, removal from the Police Budget Advisory Board, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Settlement Agreement between the City of Geneva and James McCorkle and Robert Maclean, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved and the Mayor and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City and the Geneva City Council.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into by the City of Geneva and its City Council, 47 Castle Street, Geneva, New York, hereinafter referred to as the "City", and James McCorkle and Robert Maclean, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "McCorkle and Maclean", all of whom sometimes are collectively referred to as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2020, the Geneva City Council created the Police Budget Advisory Board, and on October 7, 2020, adopted ByLaws for the Board which authorized five positions to serve for two years, and

WHEREAS, the Geneva City Council appointed James McCorkle and Robert Maclean to serve on the Police Budget Advisory Board for terms expiring on December 31, 2022, and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2022, the Geneva City Council removed James McCorkle and Robert Maclean from the Police Budget Advisory Board, after statements McCorkle and Maclean made in their personal capacities concerning the police department and their political views, and

WHEREAS, James McCorkle and Robert Maclean allege their removal from the Police Budget Advisory Board violated their rights to Free Speech and Due Process under the United States and New York State Constitutions, and

WHEREAS, the Parties are desirous of entering into an Agreement resolving all issues arising out of said matters.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The City Council agrees to amend the ByLaws of the City Police Budget Advisory Board to temporarily expand the number of positions on the Board to seven by creating two temporary positions.
2. The City Council agrees to reinstate James McCorkle and Robert Maclean to the Police Budget Advisory Board for a term commencing with the date a reinstatement resolution is passed by the City Council and ending on December 31, 2023.
3. The reinstatements of James McCorkle and Robert Maclean shall take effect upon execution of this Settlement Agreement.
4. In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, McCorkle and Maclean, along with their agents and attorneys, agree to release, remise, and forever discharge the City of Geneva and members of the City Council of and from all action and actions, cause and causes of action, suits, debts, dues, sums of money, accounts, reckoning, bonds, bills, specialties, covenants, contracts, controversies, agreements, promises, guarantees, variances, trespasses, damages, attorneys' fees, judgment, extents, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, in law or in equity, arising out of their June 1, 2022, removal from the Police Budget Advisory Board.
5. The number of positions on the Police Budget Advisory Board shall revert to five upon James McCorkle and Robert Maclean completing the term of their reinstatement.
6. This constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, resolves all issues arising out of the June 1, 2022, removal of James McCorkle and Robert Maclean from the Police Budget Advisory Board, and supersedes and cancels, except, where referenced herein, any and all prior and contemporaneous discussions, negotiations, arrangements, agreements, and understanding between the Parties to this Agreement with respect to the subject matter hereof.
7. This Agreement is a settlement and compromise of disputed claims. It shall not be interpreted as an admission of wrongdoing on the part of the City and the City Council, including but not limited to not being an admission that the City or the City Council violated their rights to Free Speech and Due Process under the United States and New York State Constitutions. This Agreement does not in any way restrict the rights of McCorkle and Maclean, or their agents and attorneys, to publicly or privately maintain their position that the June 1, 2022, removal violated their Constitutional rights.
8. This Agreement may not be modified or otherwise amended except by a written instrument that expressly refers to this Agreement and is executed by the Parties.
9. The Parties each agree further that the laws of the State of New York shall apply to the interpretation, effect and enforcement of this Agreement, without regard to New York choice of law provisions. The Parties further agree that any judicial proceeding of any nature brought by any party against any other party hereto to enforce any right or obligation under this Agreement, or arising out of any matter pertaining to this Agreement, shall be submitted exclusively to the Supreme Court of Ontario County, New York.

10. The Parties each acknowledge and agree that this Agreement may be executed in identical counterparts which, when taken together, shall constitute the single and same agreement concerning the subject matter, and that each and every term and provision hereof shall be binding and effective as to the respective obligations of the Parties as of the last date of execution by or on behalf of the Parties.

Clr. Camera said even if I might support it, I am not comfortable with this resolution for three reasons:

- It glosses over an important event and teaching moment for the CC and the Geneva public at large
- It does not completely or accurately reflect the actions by the CC at the June meeting
- What it mostly does is provide a way for the CC to save face in front of the public and misrepresent the historical record.

What actually happened was the mayor initiated the public removal of two members of PBAB (James McCorkle and Robert Maclean) this past June 2022 by offering a resolution that was not on the agenda. Then he proceeded with the vote that passed by a 5-4 margin that secured their removal and violated their individuals' civil rights under the US and NYS Constitutions. This was a breach of CC protocol and as well as the civil rights of the parties. A complaint ensued McCorkle and Maclean. The case for reinstatement of the board members is sound. CC violated these individuals' Article 1, Section 8 (NYS Constitution) and First Amendment (US Constitution) rights, which essentially protects their opinions and without fear from retaliation. The complaint also noted that the Mayor and CC in violating procedure also raised the Due Process Clause of the 14th Amendment. Rather than relegate this matter to a pedestrian and dishonest resolution and then sanctify it by a vote, I believe that we should face the consequences and embrace the opportunity to learn something from past events and CC actions since the murder of George Floyd (May 25, 2020). This was an important event in recent history and, unfortunately, it split the community in half. As a CClr. I would like us to get back at least to square one. How did we get here? I think that it is safe to

say our divisions started a long time ago but came to a head with the protests in Geneva when catalyzed by the murder of George Floyd and led by a large number of young people (embodied under the name Peoples Peaceful Protest). The protests in the streets in Geneva lasted several weeks and then gravitated to some members of the PPP working with some CClrs. and other members of the community to craft legislation that would foster more police accountability. This resulted in the formation of the PAB and the PBAB.

We had plenty of our own police problems in the Geneva even if no one had recently died. Going back several years, here are some of the ones I know about:

- It was not uncommon to hear complaints and rumors about police misconduct
- The complaint process seemed to have broken down and was losing the public trust
- Some Officer recruits had failed during training periods wasting City resources and time resulting from domestic abuse complaints and deficient fitness reports
- GPD leadership, some CClrs. and others participated in public debate and culture warfare by gaslighting members of the public and CC as supporters of Police defunding rather than having valid concerns about the complaint process and the need for more accountability.
- Direct intimidation of a CClr. through screen saver images, careless social media posts, and some stalking activity.

Many of these issues are matters of public concern and were legitimate areas of CC oversight.

As a matter of conscience, I propose a resolution that suggested the City Council agree to the following items:

1. Admission of a mistaken resolution that violated CC procedure and the Constitutional rights of a couple of community members
2. Revision of the term structure to effect reinstatement of the members
3. Reaffirmation that the US and NYS Constitutions protect the rights of all Genevans to express their viewpoints without fear of retaliation
4. The City is committed to upholding these rights for all its citizens.
5. Release of the City from further actions by the plaintiffs.

We have not been doing a very good job when under our own noses, our troubled police department has not stepped up and defended all the people in this community in the last several years. I mean ALL. So, it is time for the CC itself to be accountable and reaffirm its commitment to the Constitution by publicly accepting the settlement as originally proposed by the plaintiffs. If members of the CC choose not to, then it is for them to do so publicly, by their voice vote, not behind the veil of client attorney confidentiality. And finally, may I say, our first responsibility as CClrs. are to the people of the City of Geneva, not to any one individual or office or department of the city. Our duty is to make our residents happier and richer and safer by providing efficient and humane government services.

Clr. Pealer said that there was conjecture that the removal happened as a result of statements made by the two board members, and he said what really happened was a reorganization of city council and changes to a political appointment. He said that political appointments have political consequences when the politics of those appointed do not align with the new majority. He read from Article 2.9 of the city charter: "The appointing authority shall have the power to remove any officer or employee appointed by him or her at any time except as otherwise provided by law or this Charter and in accordance with all

provisions of law applicable thereto. In those cases where the appointing authority is the City Council, Board, Agency or Commission; the City Council, Board, Agency or Commission shall have the power to remove any of its appointive officers or employees by a majority vote of its full membership and in accordance with all provisions of law applicable thereto.” Clr. Pealer said that this is what happened.

Clr. Regan said that the dismissals were a disservice to the individuals and the city and the individual rights. She said she is pleased to support their reinstatement and glad with the end result. She noted that this is only an advisory board position, and if we have boards that all agree, we lose the chances for a critical analysis. She said she supports their reinstatement and thanked them for their patience and willingness to serve. She wished the entire committee good luck in their valuable work.

Clr. Salamendra said she agrees with Clr. Camera and with the first amendment of the United States Constitution and the New York State Constitution to protect the rights of all Genevans to express their viewpoints without fear of retaliation. She said in June, this council voted to punish two volunteers, kicking them off a board they were serving on with professionalism and good faith, because the Chief didn’t like something one of them said in the newspaper. That was wrong. And tonight we have a chance to right that wrong, but we don’t even have the courage to say that Dr. McCorkle and Dr. Maclean’s first-amendment rights were violated by this body. We don’t even have the courage to say we made a mistake. And we don’t have the courage to right the real wrong that is at the heart of this issue: We have a police department that believes it is above criticism and councilors that believe any criticism of the police should be forbidden. What happens when a police department, when a city council, and when a community is unable to hear criticism? When we are unable to hear any new ideas or consider any creative solutions, when we are stuck 20 years in the past? This sad and embarrassing episode in this city’s history communicates one thing very clearly to the larger Geneva community: If you voice your discontent, you will be targeted. It took Drs. McCorkle and Maclean seeking out legal counsel and six months time to advocate for their constitutional right to criticize the police in their capacity as **private** citizens. I apologize, on behalf of this council, that you were treated with such disrespect. It is a sign that our city is very sick that our police department and Mayor were willing to go to such lengths to silence hardworking volunteers. That’s why this conversation cannot end tonight when we pass this resolution. We have to address the unhealthy power dynamic that has allowed this to happen. We have to be honest about who is really running things. And we have to work to restore power in this city where it belongs—not with the police, but with the people.

17. MAYOR AND COUNCIL REPORTS

Clr. Burrall thanked Erica Collins for putting information on the city website about a blood drive at the Hydrant Hose Fire Department on December 28th from 9-2. He said that the next ones will be December 14th from 9-2 at the Cornell Agritech/Jordan Hall, December 21st from 1-7 at the Presbyterian Church, December 29th from 2-6:30 at the Hall Fire Department, and December 30th from 10-4 at Geneva General Hospital. Clr. Burrall reported that the BID made popcorn for 300 people at the Mayor's Tree Lighting and ran out. He said that the BID is holding a retreat for the board tomorrow from 5-9pm. He wished everyone a Merry Christmas and safe holidays and every day.

Clr. Pealer said Merry Christmas and Happy New Year. He announced for the city's birthday on January 1st, there will be two 2-hour spots for skating from 11:30-1:30 and 2-4pm. He noted that several years ago, a council removed an entire board. He wished everyone a Happy Holiday.

Clr. Regan thanked the public for their comments noting that she also had some confusion with the police study and would love an opportunity to better understand it. She said she appreciates residents taking the time to read it. She said the Green Committee, joined with the Town Sustainability Committee, met at the Echo Center in Rochester to take a tour. She said their goal with this type of outing is to help address the hopeful closing of the landfill. She noted that this is a great time to have this advisory committee as they are also working on their Mission Zero Event to possibly take place April 22nd. She noted that the last one was very successful. Clr. Regan announced that the January 1st event for our 125th Anniversary will be at the Dove Building at 1:30pm to let everyone know what we are doing with activities and the unveiling of the logo along with the public skating. Their target for the celebration will be the week of February 27th thru March 4th. She said she attended the Mayor's Tree Lighting Friday night and the great art walk on Saturday. She asked everyone to keep in mind our local merchants when shopping this holiday season and wished everyone a joyful holiday.

Clr. Camera thanked Jessica Farrell and Scott Bowes for the information on the police report. He announced that Tom Harvey sent a plan for a request for proposals (RFP) for a consultant to look at the

feasibility of moving the Finger Lakes Railroad to open up the sixth ward to the lakefront. He said he hopes all are with their families and there are no health issues during this holiday period.

Clr. Salamendra said after the last meeting Councilors Noone, Gaglianese, and Brimm approached me wanting to more about the state of housing in Geneva. Rather than fill them in privately, I thought it more appropriate to address the full council and community.

We, like communities across the country, are in a housing crisis. And we are behind solving it. The conditions are:

- Ontario County DSS reports their hotels are full with homeless families
- Last year 315 Ontario County school children were homeless
- Family Promise, which works with homeless families, reports that they have over 100 families on their waiting list
- And in our entire county there is not one shelter for homeless individuals and families
- The number of homeless families in Geneva is growing and we have absolutely nowhere to house them
- But it is not just homelessness that is impacted by our housing crisis. It is making all of our renting residents poorer:
- Economists have determined that no household should be paying more than 30% of their income for housing. But in the Finger Lakes Region, more than half of all renters are paying above 30% of their income on housing. That's more than half of our residents who can't save up for a mortgage, can't afford to shop downtown, can't afford to send their kids to daycare or summer camp or college, can't afford to start a new business.
- And while all renters are impacted by the housing crises, low-income renters are at particular risk of falling into deeper poverty, unsafe and crowded housing conditions, and homelessness.
- Rents in Geneva have skyrocketed since the start of the pandemic and section 8 vouchers no longer come close to covering the cost of rent
- Many tenants are not having their leases renewed by landlords who think they can make more money from Airbnb or remarketing as luxury housing.
- In other words, we have residents who have the funds and have the need for low-income housing and it is simply not available.

And these numbers don't even reflect the full seriousness of the problem. People's stories are devastating. Through my work with the Geneva housing taskforce that has been working since the start of COVID-19, service providers have shared stories about people with funds and desperate need, who are being turned away. There are people who have been living in hotels for months. Families who have been homeless for months. Domestic violence victims being turned away for emergency housing. Because there is none. And there is no relief in sight.

I am glad to hear that some of my fellow councilors are ready to take steps to address the housing crisis in Geneva and in Ontario County. We have said we are committed to economic development, but no one will build a business here if their employees can't find or afford housing. It is very clear, the first step to economic development is addressing our housing crisis.

And there are solutions that this council could act on in the next year that would make a real difference. We could:

- Legislate rent caps
- We could require new development to prioritize affordable housing
- We could address zoning, making residential development more possible in the city
- We could add a tax on short term rentals
- We could request more funds from the county
- We could increase public transportation to the town where there is more room for new housing development

These are just some of the practical and doable solutions that the housing task force has discussed. And if there is a commitment from this council to actually act, to actually DO something to address our housing crisis, I would be thrilled to report that to the housing committee on Monday. They are the real experts on this issue and are more than eager to work with this council to take practical steps to address the serious and growing housing crisis in our city.

Clr. Brimm said than the Geneva Housing Authority had nothing to report. He thanked everyone for coming tonight and wished everyone a Happy Holiday.

Clr. Gaglianese suggested everyone shop local during this buying season. He wished everyone a Happy Holiday, Merry Christmas, and Happy New Year.

Mayor Valentino thanked staff for the work on the Tree Lighting Ceremony saying that it was great to see the decorations and participation. He said it was great to see the Geneva Bicycle Group going around and he also noted that having horse carriage rides was awesome. Lastly, Mayor Valentino wished everyone a Happy Holiday and Happy New Year.
