RC: ask Jim Kennedy, Ontario County, compost bins. See if there are still free home energy audits. Rink PA system is hard to hear, aimed at the periphery (not rink floor) and can't be changed.

PW: if we had a cowbell, it could get people's attention and quiet them enough to possibly hear an announcement.
